Born in 1930 in Madras, Shrimati Mani Krishnaswami received her training in Carnatic vocal music at Kalakshetra, Madras; her teachers were the eminent vocalists Tiger Varadachariar, Budalur Krishnamurti Sastrigal and Mysore Vasudevacharyar. She was later a student of Musiri Subrahmanya Iyer and T K Jayarama Iyer.

Known for her large repertoire of compositions in various languages, *ragamalikas* and *pallavis*, Shrimati Mani Krishnaswami has had a long and successful concert career. A popular broadcaster, she has to her credit several gramophone records.
